The district sought solutions that could deliver the adaptive and inclusive education needed to help traditionally disadvantaged students achieve academic success.



## **Challenges Faced**

CJUSD's interest in Subject stemmed from two critical motivations. Firstly, the district faced considerable challenges, notably due to the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic. The impact on academic achievement was profound, with 20.5% of the class of 2023 seniors receiving at least one failing grade. Additionally, 281 seniors across the district's three comprehensive high schools were in jeopardy of not graduating on time because they lacked the necessary credits. Aiming to boost graduation rates not only for the class of 2023 but also looking ahead to 2024 was a significant concern.

Secondly, the district's aims to equip every student with the essential foundation for pursuing higher education and securing a career that offers a sustainable income.

#### Solution

In response to the challenge, CJUSD sought assistance from Subject, to provide students an opportunity to recover credits and explore new interests. Subject takes a modern approach to education, utilizing short-form video lessons that leverage multimedia, narrative techniques, and relatable subject matter tailored to how today's students consume information.



It was evident the team at Subject cared about our district and demonstrated a strong commitment to supporting our district's unique needs, Dr. Eric Mooney said.

They were attentive to hearing about our district's graduation criteria, timelines and specific data points ensuring alignment in our overall goals of not only improving graduation rates for the class of 2023, but 2024 as well," he said.

All of this harmonizes with the district's mission statement, he said, which promotes engaging, challenging and enriching opportunities and specialized programs so that each student can pursue college and career success, while also becoming compassionate human beings able to communicate, and even advocate, for themselves. Subject has helped substantially with the core content component.

#### **Implementation**

Initially, a pilot program called Mission 220 was introduced at one site by the district. It involved credit recovery classes provided by Subject for extended-day intervention, aiding 41 students in overcoming the academic challenges brought on by COVID.

Following this achievement, CJUSD expanded the use of Subject to all five comprehensive sites. Students at Colton began enrolling directly with Subject alongside their regular classes.

Notably, Photography has been super popular with students at Colton, Bloomington and Grand Terrace high schools, while students also have gravitated towards English and Financial Literacy at Bloomington High and Psychology and Cryptocurrency at Grand Terrace.


